Priority Areas

Areas of priority for funding proposals submitted to the Boone County Children’s Services Board (BCCSB) in June of 2014 were determined by the issues identified in the *Community Input Report* prepared by Institute of Public Policy, Harry S. Truman School of Public Affairs, University of Missouri. The issues identified were:

Structures/Systems: Collaboration barriers, billing and other systemic challenges such as, need for family-based services coordination between agencies, lack of integration between mental and physical health systems, lack of insurance coverage for prevention services.

Education: Professional development, mental health stigma among parents and the community-at-large.

Access: Shortages, bottlenecks and limited agency resources to meet the current demand in the community for services.

In addition to the issues identified by the *Community Input Report* the BCCSB also set a funding priority for prevention services.

At-Risk Prevention: Prevention programs targeted at populations identified to be statistically more likely than others to experience mental health and substance abuse issues.

In-Risk Prevention: Prevention programs targeted at populations identified to be in need of support because of an existing mental health or substance abuse issue.

Funding Opportunities

The funding opportunity for the BCCSB in relation to the priority areas identified is the issue of Systems/Structures. Expansion of programs in each of the other priority areas would also be beneficial to expand availability of necessary services. The issue of Systems/Structures may be addressed by an “Access to Services” program.
