Definition of Work:

Responsible for providing instruction and assistance in various art mediums. Responsible for submitting orders for art supplies and maintenance of art room. Must be proficient in running equipment, such as kiln and pottery wheel. Approximately 10 hours per week, Monday through Friday.

Physical Demands

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently required to walk; sit; and talk; or hear. The employee is routinely required to work with the hand or hands in handling, seizing, holding, or grasping motions and with the fingers in picking or pinching actions; is occasionally required to maintain body equilibrium while bending at the waist or at the knees. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision and distance vision.

Work Environment

The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those an employee encounters while performing the primary functions of this job. Detention/jail conditions. Potential problems may exist with juveniles who do not follow the rules and are subject to sanctions. The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate.
