#### ADDENDUM #2

#### TO REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL - BOONE COUNTY, MISSOURI 9-1-1 Geographic Information System Request for Proposal Number: 23-29APR03

This addendum is issued in accordance with the Instructions to Offerors and is hereby incorporated into and made a part of the Proposal Documents. Offerors are reminded that receipt of this addendum should be acknowledged and submitted with Offeror's *Response Page*.

Specifications for the above noted Request for Proposal and the work covered thereby are herein modified as follows, and except as set forth herein, otherwise remain unchanged and in full force and effect:

#### PROPOSAL DOCUMENTS:

## 1) ADD Paragraph 3.2.2.1. to page 9:

The wireless providers located in Boone County include AT&T Wireless, US Cellular, T-Mobile, Cingular, Sprint PCS, and Nextel. The wireless carriers are providing all tower locations lat/long in decimal degrees, the sector number for the tower and the angle of coverage and direction of the sector.

2) ADD to Paragraph 3.2.2., page 9 under Files and Data that Still Need to be Created or Tweaked, under Site Layer for the Entire County:

The site layer is a point representation of all structures in Boone County. There is currently a point layer showing all meter locations for the unincorporated Boone County area which would represent approximately 35% of all the addresses. This would be a part of the project if the Offeror deems it necessary in order to provide a fully functioning system as described in the scope of work.

The site layer being created is based on multiple sources of data including the County E911 database from the LEC (Local Exchange Carrier), Boone Electric meter locations, the County MSAG database, Columbia Billing address and utility location information. The site layer is a point layer where the footprint data would be a polygon layer.

### 3) ADD Paragraph 3.2.2.2. to page 9:

Boone County will provide to the Contractor, access to the most current digital aerial imagery.

**4) ADD to Paragraph 3.2.2., page 9** under Files and Data that Still Need to be Created or Tweaked, under A Common Name Table for the Site Layer Once Created:

Our CAD system has a file of common names (i.e. McDonalds, Walmart, park names) that are associated with their addresses. This information must be available to be input into the map software and offer a list of possible locations from which the user may pick.

5) ADD to Paragraph 3.2.2., page 9 under Files That are Complete, under Point File of Approximately Every Physical Address in Boone County...:

The point file of approximately every physical address in Boone County will not be complete before the contract award. The completion of this dataset will only be the Offeror's responsibility if they believe it is needed to provide a fully functional system as described in the scope of work.

# 6) ADD to paragraph 3.3.12., page 11:

The 60 days is to install the needed software and hardware in the PSJC center in order to be able to plot E911 wireless and wireline calls. If it is determined by the Offeror that some of the data creation may take longer, then it should be noted by the Offeror in their proposal.

### 7) ADD to paragraph 3.2.1., page 8:

There are approximately 12 jurisdictions in Boone County. PSJC currently only uses communities for ESN delineations because we are the sole PSAP for Boone County.

There are approximately 25 Cell towers in Boone County. PSJC is still collecting data from the wireless providers and estimates there are approximately three carriers per tower and three sectors per carrier with approximately 225 sectors total.

8) ADD to paragraph 3.2.2., page 8, under Files That are Complete, under Building Footprint Files which are in the Process of Being Created for the City of Columbia:

The Contractor will not be responsible for completing the footprint data inside the City. This is being done through another department and process.

9) ADD to paragraph 3.2.2., page 8, under Files and Data That Still Need to be Completed or Tweaked, under Building Footprint Data for Areas Outside the City Limits of Columbia, Missouri:

The County footprint data would be an outline of any building with a side longer than 20 foot. (This does eliminate some smaller sheds and other miscellaneous structures). The footprints should be attributed with address information and area. They do not have to be the same table structure as the City of Columbia. The City's process is not yet complete so PSJC can not provide the City table structure information to Offerors.

The building footprint layer might be linked to another database at some point in time, so the address format should be consistent with E911 addresses.

10) ADD to paragraph 3.2.2., page 9, under Files That are Complete, under Current Copy of MSAG and ESN list of the entire County:

Boone County does not need the Contractor to create Law, EMS (Ambulance), and Fire layers as well. All of these layers are already created, and are in the process of being enhanced to parcel accuracy by our staff.
