## NOTICE TO BIDDERS

**Boone County, Missouri is accepting sealed bids for 75-08NOV05 Smith Hatchery Road Culvert Replacement Project.**

**Project Construction:** *A 96" existing culvert will be replaced along Smith Hatchery Road with a 120" CMP. The new culvert will be bolted to the existing 120" DNR culvert which runs under the Katy Trail in order to fill the existing scoured out hole which lies between the two pipes. The hole will be backfilled and compacted and a side-inlet drainage slab will be constructed along with an 18" CMP which will connect to the proposed 120" CMP. Both the 18" CMP and the 120" CMP will be furnished by Boone County Public Works along with the necessary bolts to connect to the DNR pipe. The road will be widened through the project area and a headwall will be constructed on the east side of Smith Hatchery along with rip rap and turf reinforcement on the upstream side of the proposed pipe to protect the banks from erosion, since there is a bend in the channel immediately upstream of the pipe.*

**Sealed bids, subject to the Instructions and General Conditions of Bidding, will be accepted until 9:15 A.M. on November 8, 2005, at the Boone County Purchasing Office, 601 E. Walnut, Room 209, Columbia, Missouri, 65201. Bids received after the above specified time for acceptance will be returned to the sender unopened.**

**The bid is scheduled to be publicly opened after 9:30 A.M. on November 8, 2005 in the Boone County Commission Chambers, 801 E. Walnut, Columbia, MO 65201.**

The County reserves the right to select and award the bid item or items which best suit its needs, whether the price is the lowest or not, and also reserves the right to reject any and all bids or waive informalities or irregularities.

Not less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages, as found by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations of Missouri, shall be paid to all workers performing work under this Contract. The Contractor's bond shall include such provisions as will guarantee the faithful performance of the prevailing hourly wage rate as provided by the Contract.

Boone County notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award. The bidder will insure that Disadvantage Business Enterprises will have the opportunity to participate in the performance of this contract or any subcontracts.
