ADDENDUM #1 - Issued June 17, 2009

This addendum is issued in accordance with the Request for Bid and is hereby incorporated into and made a part of the Request for Bid Documents. Bidders are reminded that receipt of this addendum **MUST** be acknowledged and submitted with Bidder's *Response Form*.

Specifications for the above noted Request for Bid and the work covered thereby are herein modified as follows, and except as set forth herein, otherwise remain unchanged and in full force and effect:

- I. Add attached OSHA Specifications Language to the Bid Specifications as follows on page two of this addendum.**
- II. Add attached Affidavit of Compliance With OSHA to the Bid Specifications as follows on page three of this addendum.**
 - a. Please note that this must be notarized.
- III. Modify detail 4 on sheet C504 as follows:**
 - a. Delete the note "CMP Mitered End Section" in its entirety and replace with "CMP Flared End Section."
- IV. This clarification is from the Pre-Bid Meeting:**
 - a. "The transitions between the curb and gutter of the type M inlets and the roll back curb and gutter shall be included in the per inlet cost of Type M inlets."
- V. Replace Bid Form with the Revised Bid Form as follows on page four of this addendum.**

**BID SPECIFICATIONS LANGUAGE FOR OSHA TRAINING
REQUIRED FOR PUBLIC WORKS TO BE IN PROGRESS
AFTER AUGUST 28, 2009**

OSHA Program Requirements – The Contractor is familiar with the requirements of 292.675 RSMo. The Contractor shall provide a ten-hour Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) construction safety program for their on-site employees, subcontractors or others acting on behalf of Contractor on-site which meets the requirements of 292.675 RSMo.

The Contractor and each subcontractor shall keep accurate records of those employees who are working on-site and a record of each such employee's completion of the OSHA program.

The Contractor shall forfeit as a penalty to the County the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) plus One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each employee employed by the Contractor or subcontractor, for each calendar day, or portion thereof, such employee is found to be employed in violation of 292.675 RSMo. Said amounts shall be withheld from all sums and amounts due under this provision when making payments to the Contractor.
