2.	ADD the following bid item to the Response Form, Section I, for the above referenced Request for Bid: Item 9- Quote a unit cost per square foot, for application of a 'micro topping' product over concrete surfaces described in the bid's primary specifications and floor diagram for receiving stain application. Use of this product will be as needed only, and with approval by Owner. Provide with bid the Mfr specifications for evaluation purposes.  Product and application: \$SQFT
3.	If patch for cracks and patches required, use of polymer modified cement material, such as Sakrete, is acceptable.
4.	OSHA Program Requirements, Contract Conditions, Page 14 of RFB 30-28JUL14: The question was raised during the Pre-Bid Conference held Tuesday, July 15, 2014 at the Sheriff's Department, of the relevance of the requirement for this project.  Response: The Construction Safety Training Act per Missouri Revised Statutes, Chapter 292, Section 292.675, requires all contractors and subcontractors entering into contracts with public bodies for construction of public works to train their on-site employees regarding potential hazards they may encounter. (Definition of 'public works' per Statutes, are all fixed works constructed for public use or benefit or paid for wholly or in part out of public funds.) Either an OSHA program or a similar program approved by the Division of Labor Standards is acceptable. The OSHA training requirement remains as part of this Request for Bid.
4.	ASBESTOS-Analysis results from samples taken from floor tile at Sheriff's Department were negative for asbestos. Results are available to bidders upon request.  By:  Elizabeth Sanders, CPPB Senior Buyer, Purchasing
