TO: All contractors that work in Boone County, Missouri on sites greater than one acre.

RE: Qualified Stormwater Installer Program and Green Installer Designation

Boone County's Qualified Installer Program assists Site Foremen and ESC Inspectors with required training to meet the local and National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System General Permit requirements. The program provides training to properly inspect erosion prevention and sediment control measures, document inspections and construct functioning stormwater systems.

Qualified Installer Requirements

- Attend 2 County sponsored trainings per year
- Maintain clean sites
- Minimal violations
- Build Stormwater features according to plans

The goal of the program is to promote the proper design, construction, and maintenance of erosion and sediment controls during construction and to assure the proper long-term operation and maintenance of stormwater systems after construction is completed.

The training program is primarily directed towards inspectors and contractors, however public works personnel and engineers may also benefit.

Trainings: Each participant who attends two Boone County trainings per year will be listed as a *Qualified Installer*. Once a project managed by that installer has been clean for six months; violations are corrected within the required time and stormwater features are built according to plans, that installer will become a *Green Installer*.
