Report of Activity - 2014

During the past year, the Resource Management Department processed 9 requests to rezone land. Eight of the requests were considered by the County Commission and subsequently approved.

The requests that received approval totaled **153.23** acres of land. The largest request that was approved involved rezoning land that was zoned A-R (Agriculture Residential) to R-SP (Planned Residential). That request was for 65.51 acres of land.

The Commission also received 6 requests for conditional use permits. All six were approved.

During 2013, the Planning and Zoning Commission approved 27 final plats comprising 262.59 acres, divided into 61 lots. There were 5 preliminary plats that comprised 313 lots on 139.23 acres. In addition, the Planning Division processed 39 Administrative Surveys, 18 Family Transfer requests, 24 land disturbance permits, 6 stormwater discharge permits and 31 floodplain development permits.




