Weather permitting Boone County, through contractor Christensen Construction Co., will be performing Fog Seal treatments to the following Boone County roads:

Roads are expected to be treated one lane at a time (half width of road). While a lane is being treated, one way traffic will be allowed on the opposite lane as directed by flaggers. After the treated lane has cured (2-4 hours) and opened to traffic, the opposite lane will be treated. Walking or driving on wet sealant can result in damage to vehicles, driveways, clothing, etc.

Please use caution in all work zones and find alternate routes if necessary.
