EVENT: Lake of the Woods Subdivision Street Rebuild

## FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

Boone County Resource Management, through contractor Christensen Construction Company, will be performing a street rebuild project in portions of the Lake of the Woods Subdivision. Streets to be rehabilitated include Rocky Mountain Avenue, Crater Lake Drive, Glacier Drive, and Yosemite Avenue. This project will involve spot repair of curb and gutter, removal of existing concrete street pavement, excavation of underlying soil, installation of base rock and new asphalt pavement.

Work will begin **Monday, June 11, 2018** and will last approximately ten weeks, weather permitting. Vehicle access and on-street parking will be restricted in the work zones Monday-Friday, 7:00 am – 6:00 pm. "No Parking" signs will be posted and violators may be subject to tow at their expense. Access in and out of driveways will be restricted as well. A representative from the contractor will be coordinating with homeowners on an individual basis to help coordinate access issues.

The project will be constructed in phases to help lessen the number of people affected. Construction will be noisy and dusty. All motorists are urged to exercise caution in work zones and follow posted signage or instructions from onsite personnel. We understand the inconveniences of construction and appreciate your cooperation as we work to make these improvements. Please note that weather conditions can affect project start and end dates.
